# 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Family Ownership

1974 - 2023

Stockman's Inn was established in 1969 when Marv Walter, Bud Nichols and Shie Foudree began selling sandwiches, pop and Pabst Blue Ribbon beer inside the original Carcass Display Building. Champion beef, pork, and lamb carcasses were displayed through the big glass windows of the building's large walk-in cooler. The cooler still exists, and today serves as a food and beer keg storage area. The original building is currently the kitchen, storage and air-conditioned Dining Room of Stockman's Inn.

In early 1972 Lyle Kreps took over Mr. Foudree's interest in Stockman's. An outside bar, protected by an awning, was then constructed on the south side of the building.

In 1974 Lyle purchased Marv and Bud's interest in the business.

This year marks the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Kreps family - Lyle, his wife Sharon, their children Brian, Jason, Jennifer and their families, operating Stockman's Inn!

In 1985 a separate building was constructed around the large sycamore tree to the west and umbrella tables were added between the two buildings. The Stockman's Inn "Treehouse", as it is affectionately called, gave a needed presence to the west and the outdoor seating has become very popular.

In late 1999 and early 2000, the fair restored the Cattle Barn. In the process improvements were made to the Stockman's Inn building and a new "Treehouse" was built with "Iowa's Largest Cowboy Hat" as its roof.

Stockman's Inn has grown from being able to seat about 80 people to about 350, expanded from 5 employees to about 70, and has served Governors, Senators, Presidential candidates and nationally known entertainers.

But our favorite customers will always be the farm families, our friends and acquaintances, and everyone in a cowboy hat! We still love to hear people say, "I'll meet ya' at Stockman's!". To those who have come and gone, and to all who return each year - over the past 50 years and more - we want to say...
